**IMPORTANT ADVISORY**

**Subject: Advisory to Candidates figuring in final selection list of PARVAAZ Scheme of Mission Youth.**

Whereas, the Final Selection List of Candidates under PARVAAZ Scheme was issued by Mission Youth on 26-08-2022 wherein candidates figuring in the Selection List were allocated institutes based on the preferences submitted and were further instructed to report to the allotted institute by/before along with prescribed documents by or before 03-08-2022;

Whereas, Mission Youth has clearly issued clear instructions to the candidates in the final notice. But, still many candidates are submitting requests through various channels (twitter/email etc.) for change in the allotted institute based on messages circulating on social media/messaging platforms that candidates have been allowed to change their allotted institute along with other things like Mission Youth shall be providing accommodation/ optional course to the students;

Whereas, the same has come to the notice of Mission Youth and it has been felt that an advisory is issued for all the candidates figuring in the final list;

**As such, through the medium of this advisory, the candidates are intimated as under:**

1. Since the allotment of institutes has been made through a standardized process based on the preference submitted by the candidates themselves, there is no reason for changing the institute allotment made by Mission Youth. All candidates are accordingly advised to join the allotted institute before the stipulated time i.e. 03-09-2022.

**However, based on the vacancy position after the admission process, request for change in institute may be considered on case-on-case basis and under compelling circumstances only.**

2. Regarding accommodation, the scheme guidelines do not provide for boarding/ lodging component. The same has been clearly mentioned in the notification under which candidates applied for the scheme and to which the candidates agreed at the time of application submission. As such, there shall be no change in the criteria as laid down under the guidelines of the scheme.
3. The course being offered under the program is GS Foundation Course only. The same is being done as standardized course must be provided to all the candidates enrolled under the program and it is not possible to provide standardized course with various available options that can be chosen by the candidates as per their choice.
4. It has also come to the notice of Mission Youth that some candidates are mis-leading other candidates by circulating messages on various social media/messaging platforms posing to be

speaking on behalf of officers/officials of Mission Youth/ group of candidates. Such behavior has been seen seriously as such messages/posts are affecting the admission process, start of coaching and may even leave genuine candidates suffering at the end. The terms and the conditions of the coaching program have been clearly stated in the final selection notice and rest of the issues have also been clearly addressed through the medium of this advisory. Considering the same, candidates are warned not to spread mis-information or mis-lead other candidates.

**Candidates may note that appropriate action to the extent of cancellation of selection shall be initiated against any such candidates found/reported to be indulging in rumor-mongering/ spreading mis-information/ mis-leading other candidates.**
